IV. Financial Update

Elisha gave an update of the financial accounts to the members. A revised budget should be coming around the end of October.

a. Main Account

- 1. Donations are doing well.
- 2. Some donors are the Credit Union of TX, Balfour and Wylie ER
- 3. Spirit wear is doing well, around \$7700 for the quarter.
- 4. Telethon is only at around \$38,000, a long way from the goal of \$50,000. Donations from the students' lists are still welcome.
- 5. WMI income so far is around \$4400 from band entries. Expenses are trickling in for this. More information will come after WMI is completed.
- 6. Special purchases- there is a good amount set aside for things around the band hall.

b. Concessions account

- 1. This account has around \$28,00 in revenue so far. It's doing better than last year a positive. Stock expenses are around \$10,000 to replenish.
- 2. Kona Ice donates a portion of their sales.
- 3. Concessions is a big fundraiser for the band everyone benefits from it.
- 4. WMI is also a big fundraiser for our band.

c. Flow thru account

- 1. All band fees should be paid by now. Around \$78,500 has been brought in.
- 2. Color guard brought in about \$20,000 \$10,000 in fees.
